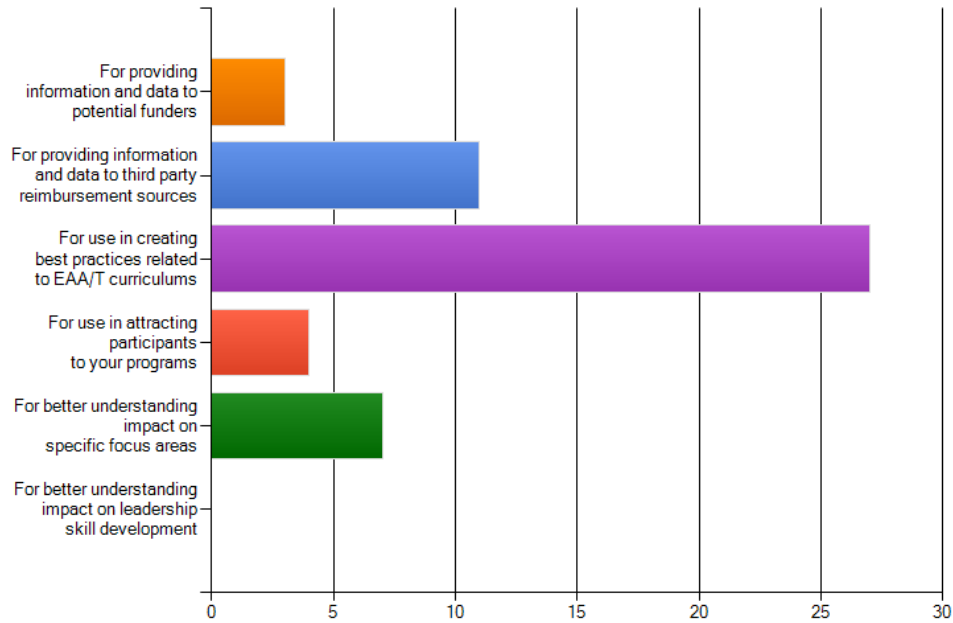

I apologize for any confusion this may create. These charts were created within Survey Monkey so I had to work within the parameters of what was available.

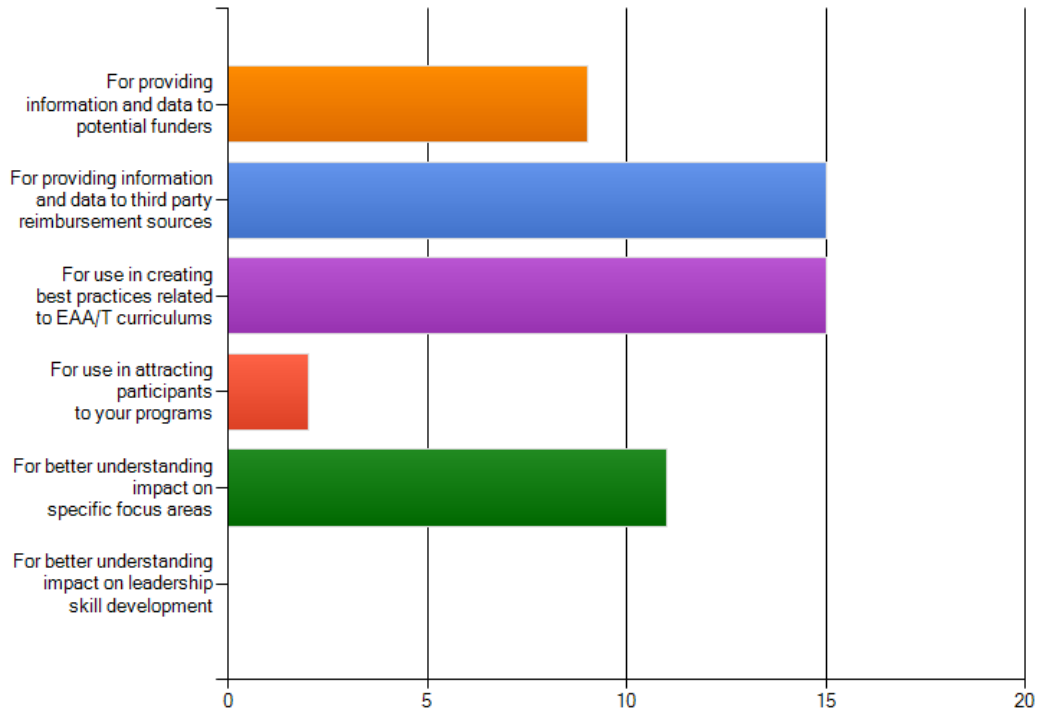
THERAPISTS WORKING IN PHYSICAL FIELD

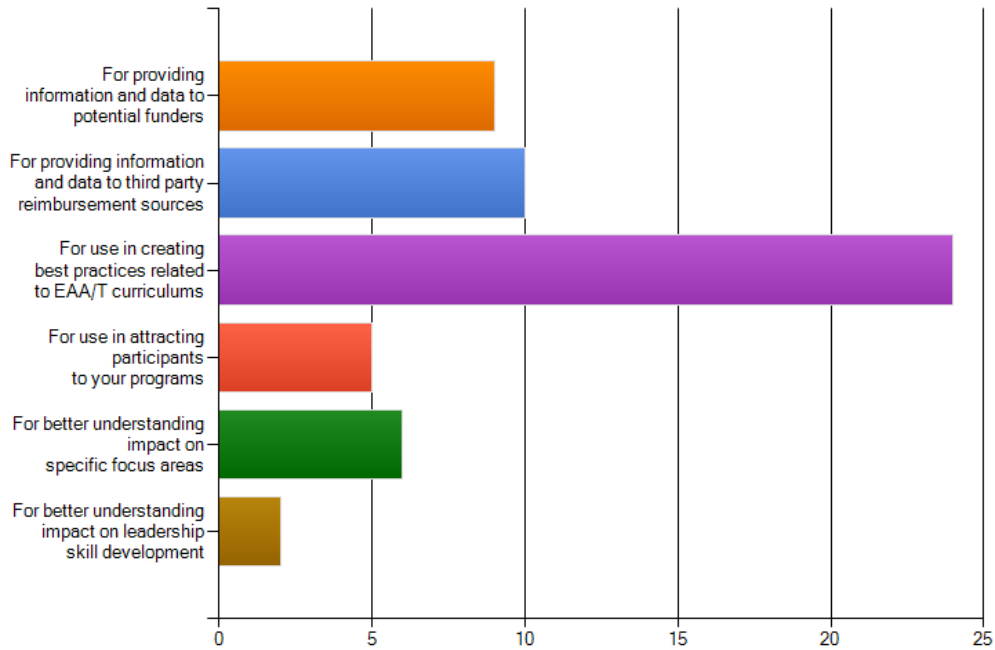

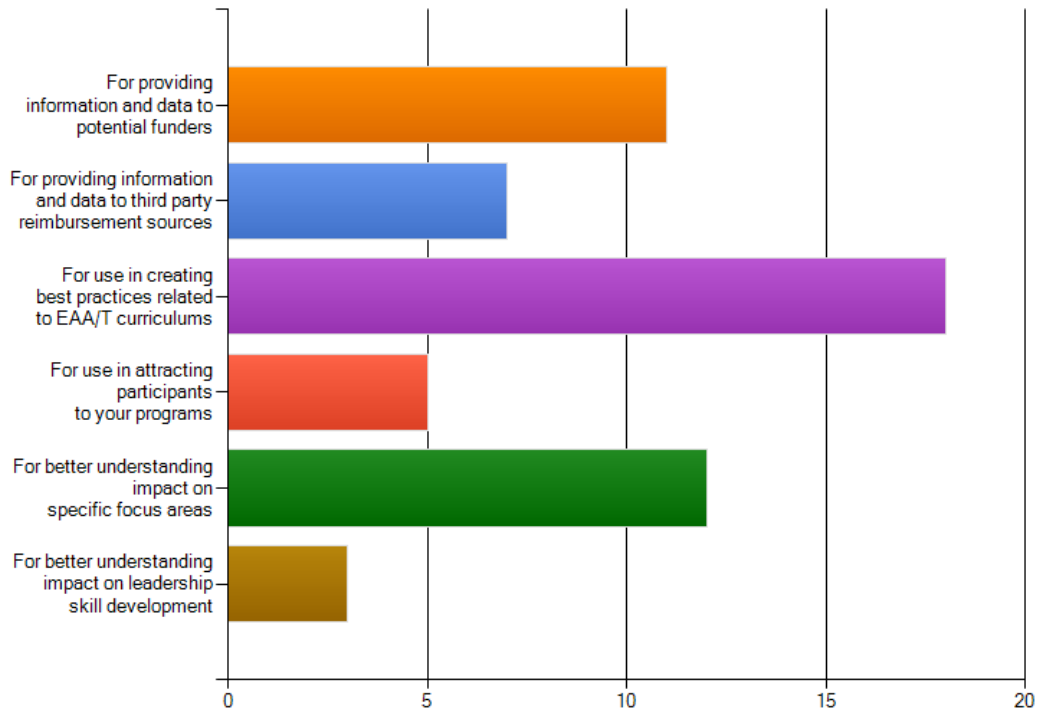
THERAPISTS WORKING IN PSYCHOLOGICAL FIELD

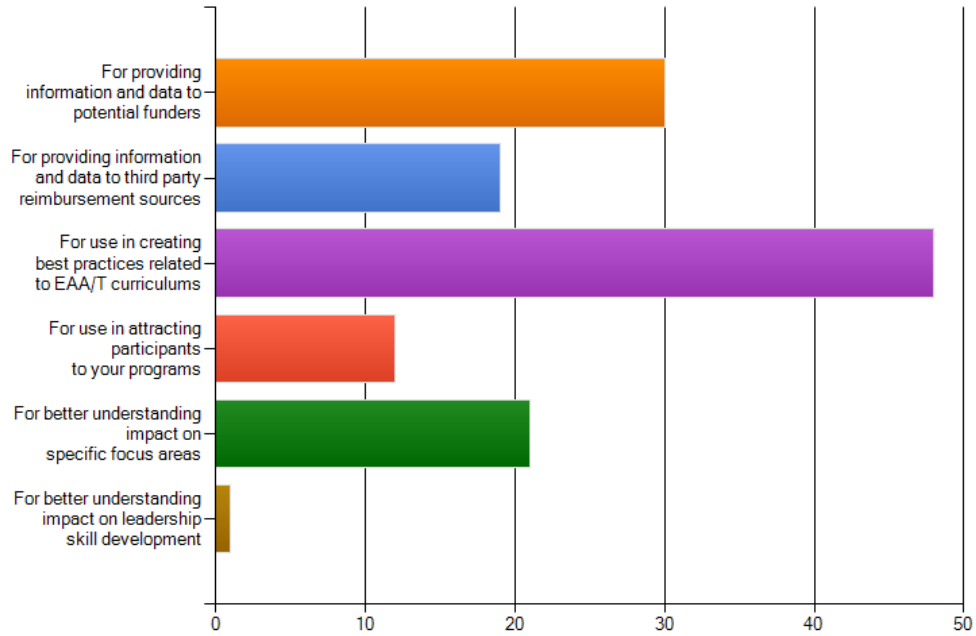

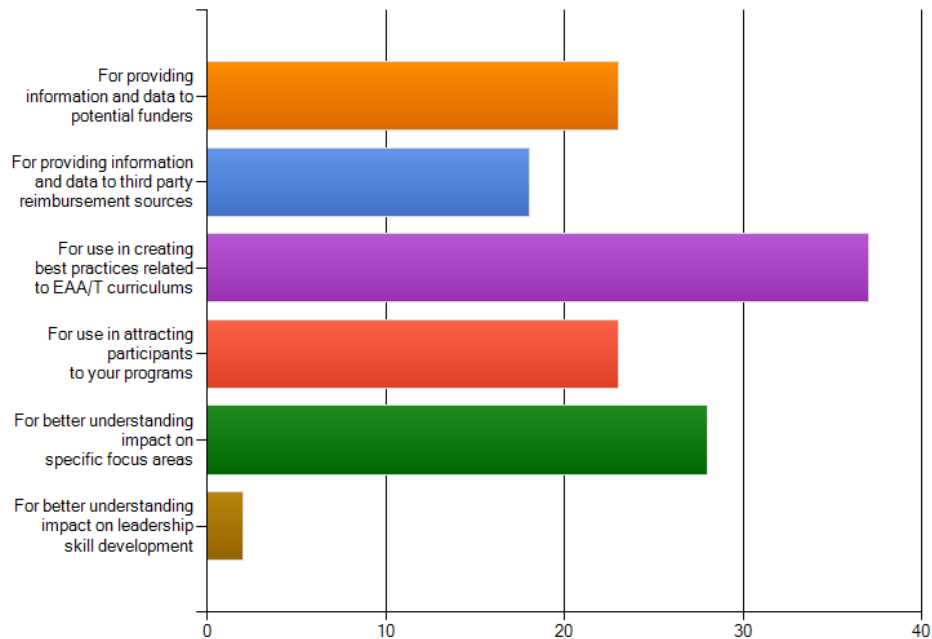

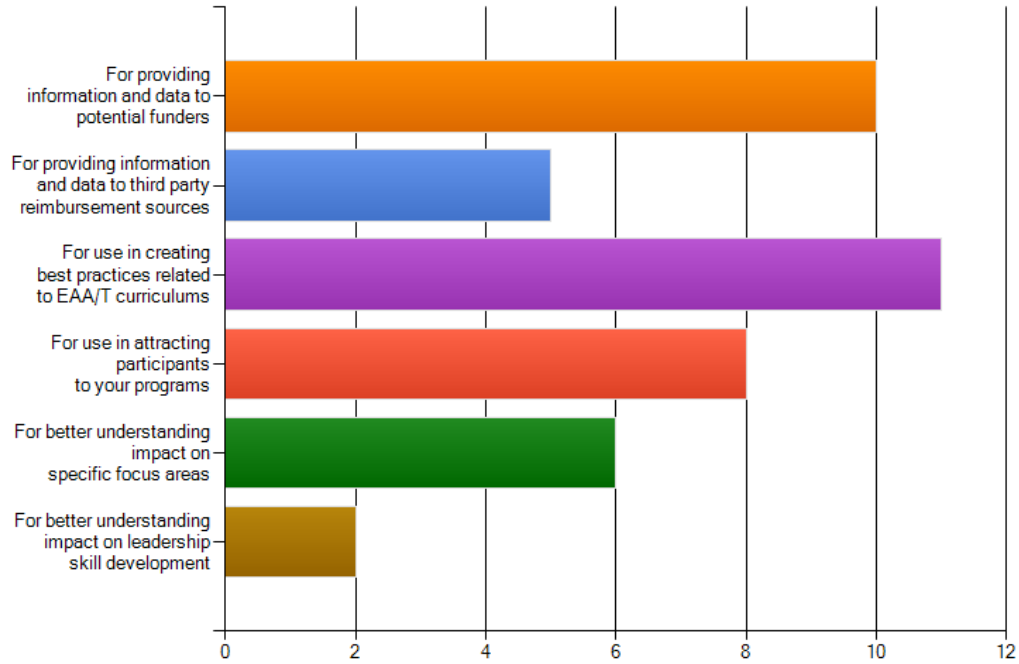

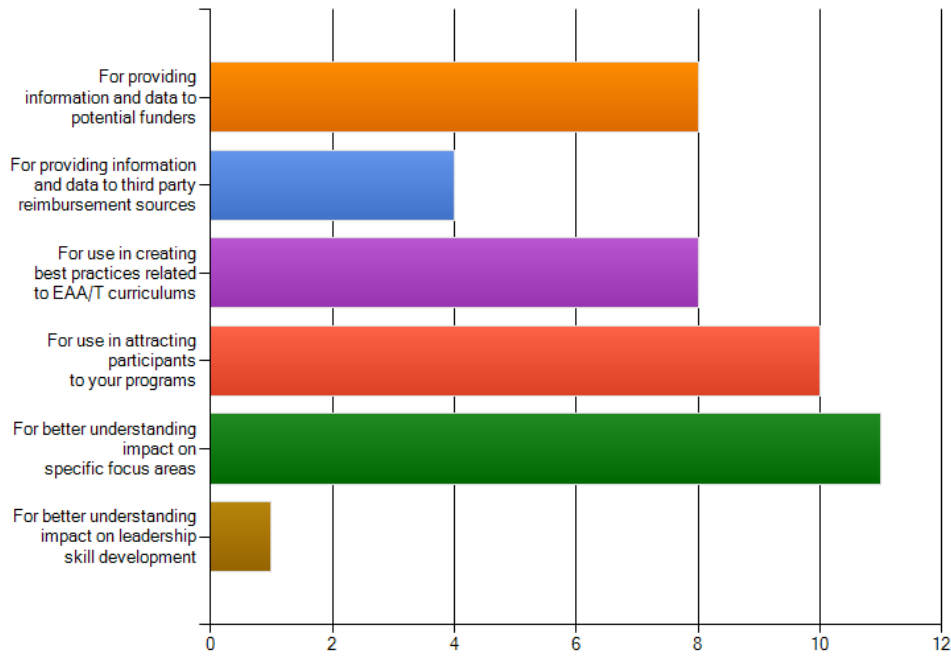

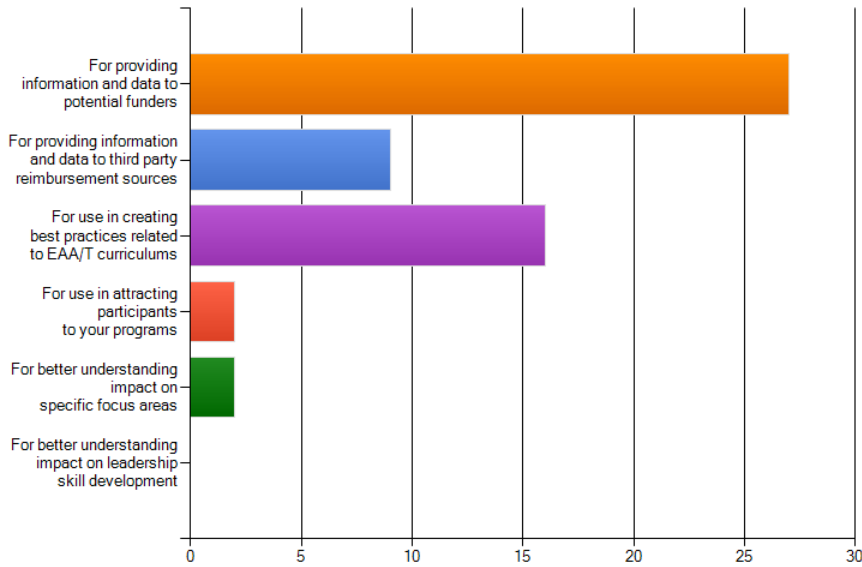

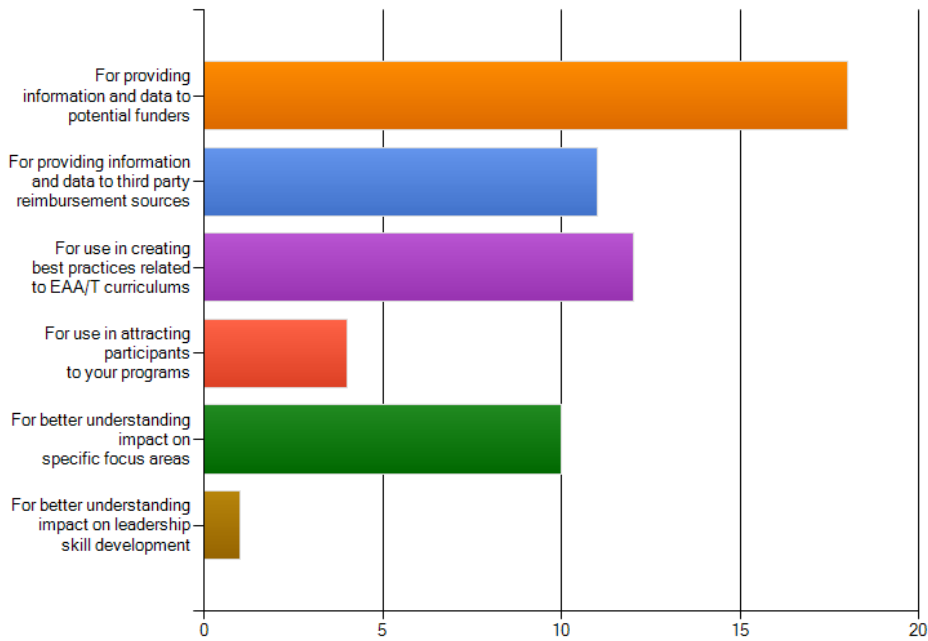

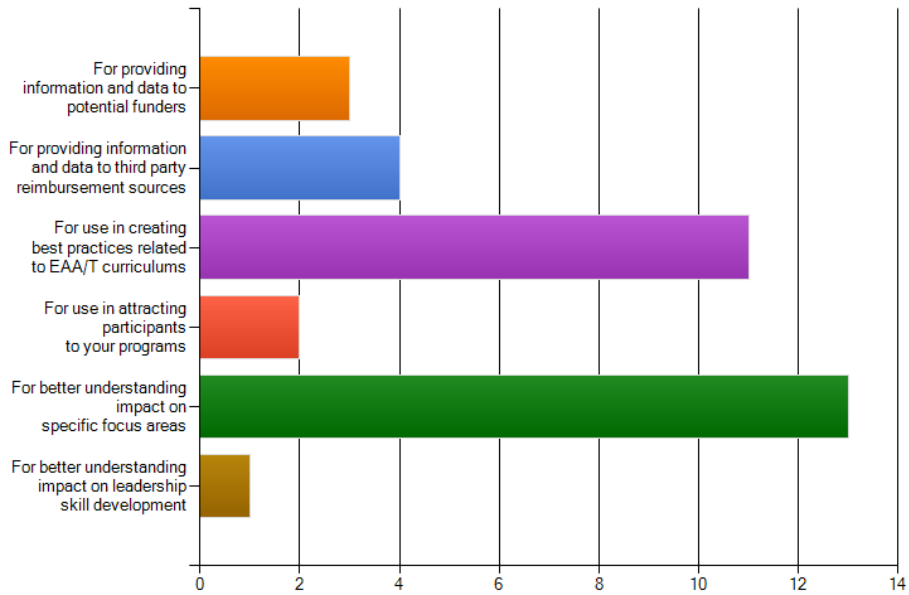

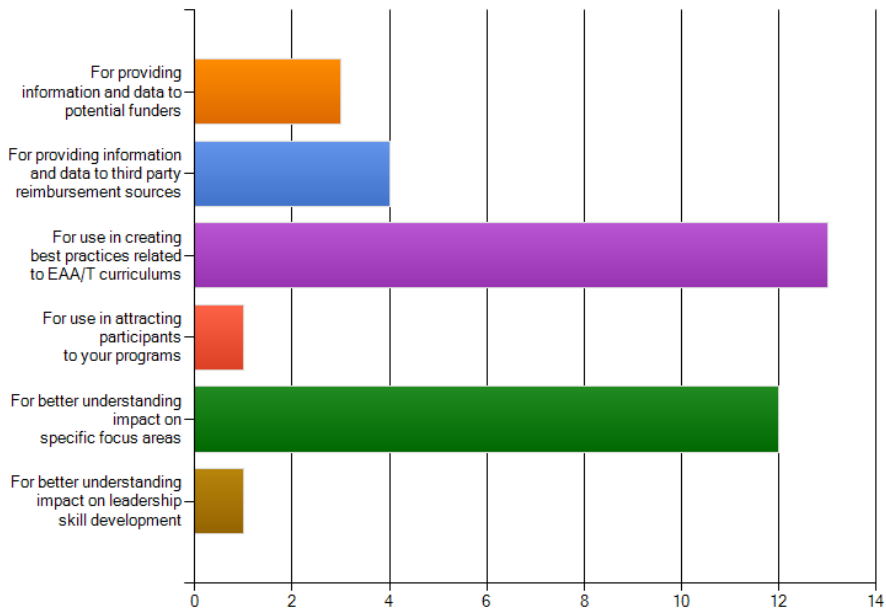

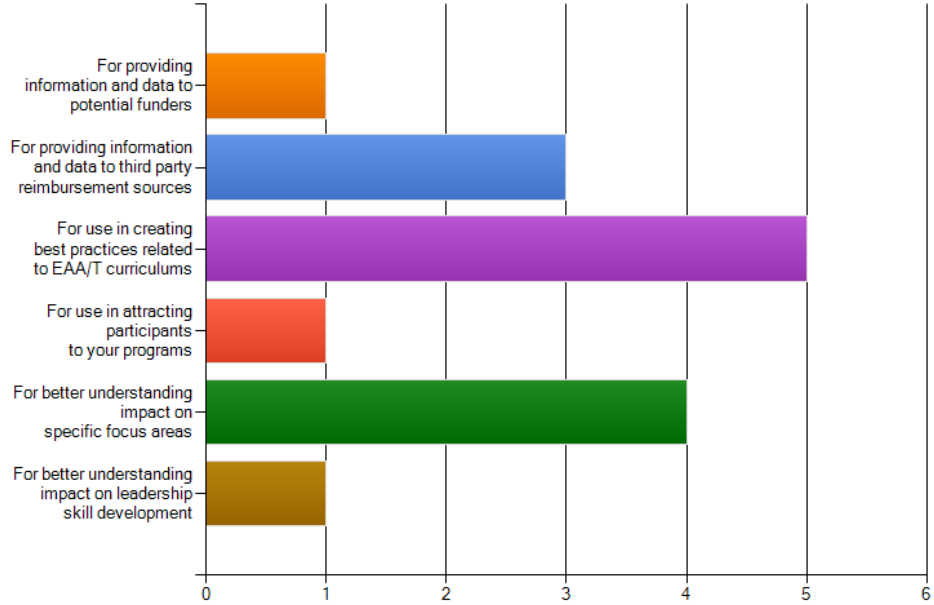

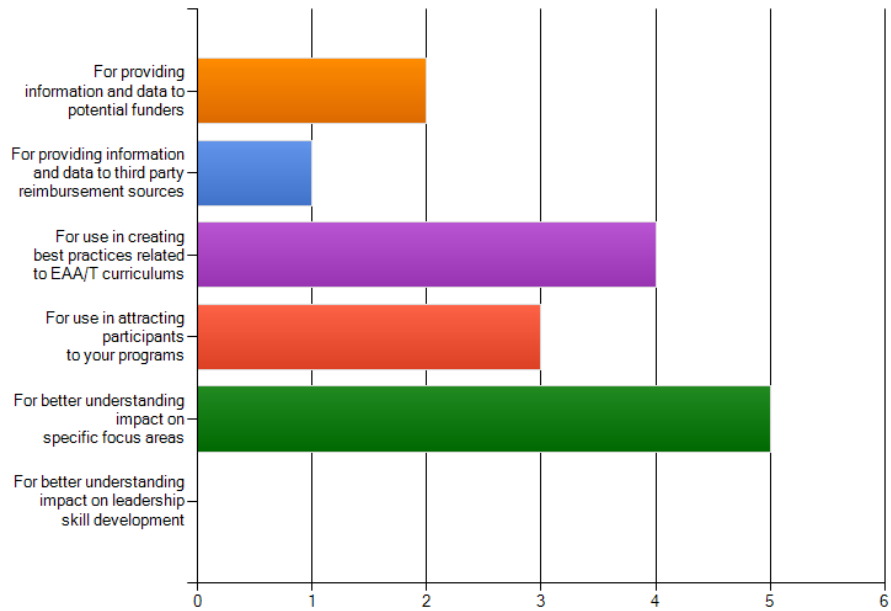

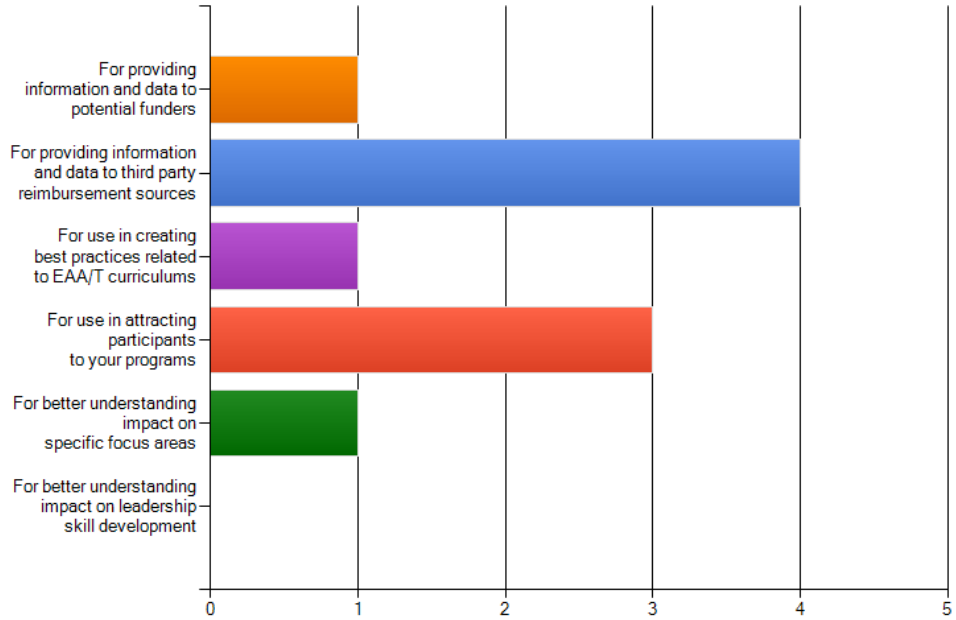
