Statistical Descriptions of Applications from the May 2010 Call for Proposals

Representation Statistics:

- 37 applications from 19 states in the U.S.A. and from 7 different countries
- 6 of the 7 countries had a team member from Germany involved
- 27 universities were represented
- 30+ EAA/T programs were represented

Financial Information:

- Asked for less than \$25,000: 4 applicants
- Asked for 25,001-\$49,999: 15 applicants
- Asked for 50,000: 18 applicants

Main Focuses of 2010 Proposals:

- Hippotherapy: 1
- Education: 1
- Mental Health/Education: 2
- Mental Health: 16
- Mental Health/Physical Health: 2
- Horse-Human Relationship: 5
- Horse-Human Relationship combined with Mental Health focus: 2
- Physical Therapy: 3
- Speech Therapy: 1
- Speech Therapy combined with Education focus: 1
- Occupational Therapy: 1
- Occupational/Physical Therapy: 1
- One applicant remains unsure of focus #36: 1

Review Process:

Review Phase I (3 reviewers) 14 proposals eliminated

Review Phase II (2-3 reviewers reviewed and scored each proposal) 20 proposals eliminated

Review Phase III (3 reviewers evaluated all remaining proposals, and concluded with their recommendation to the board)

Final Decision – by the Board of Directors
